Nowy Styl is a leading provider of comprehensive furniture solutions for office and public spaces. Founded in 1992 in Poland, the company initially focused on assembling a select range of simple office chair models. Today, Nowy Styl manufactures over 220 product lines, encompassing a wide array of swivel chairs, conference & café chairs, venue & beam seating, desking & office storage systems, soft seating, acoustic pods, and panels. It exports to more than 70 countries worldwide, with 84% of our sales revenue derived from international markets. In 2024, it generated revenue of €306.7 million, establishing the company as Europe's third-largest office furniture manufacturer.

As of year-end 2024, **Nowy Styl** employed approximately 3,500 employees. It operates branches in 11 countries: Poland, Germany, France, Switzerland, Austria, the Netherlands, the UK, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, and the UAE. The production facilities are located in Poland, Germany, and Switzerland. While office furniture constitutes the core of Nowy Styl's operations, it has developed presence in synergistic sectors, including airport terminals, healthcare and care facilities, hospitality, education, sports and cultural venues, cinemas and home office environments.

Nowy Styl owes its growth to innovative management practices and international expansion – including 10 completed acquisitions. Through these acquisitions, it has integrated companies' competencies, organizational structures, and product portfolios. The company is proud to operate under the main brand Nowy Styl across all markets, supported by complementary **brands Kusch+Co, Forum by Nowy Styl, Sitag by Nowy Styl, and Sohos by Nowy Styl.**

Nowy Styl has always been committed to sustainability, continually introducing eco-friendly materials, achieving a 50% reduction in CO2 since 2018, and powering the production campus in Jasło, Poland, with 100% renewable electricity. In 2025, Nowy Styl earned the Platinum EcoVadis Medal for the fourth consecutive year. In the near term, it will launch two competence centers in Germany and Poland focused on repairing and refurbishing pre-owned furniture to extend product lifecycles.
